When Airmen are promoted, receive educational or training achievements, deploy or earn a medal they are eligible for the hometown news release program.

The program provides accurate and timely news releases about wing member's promotions, medals, assignments and other special accomplishments to their friends and family members via newspapers, radio stations and television stations in their hometown.

Hometown News Release, Department of Defense Form 2266, is a quick and simple way to showcase the accomplishments of wing members. Wing members can fill out the form and turn it in to the 512th Airlift Wing Public Affairs office, which forwards it to the Joint Hometown News Service. The San Antonio, Texas, based service uses the form to produce a news release and markets it to media outlets in locations where the service member has family ties.
