Originally called Declaration Day, because of "decorating" the graves of Civil War veterans, it became a national holiday in 1971 and was renamed Memorial Day. Colonel Bright is responsible for 1,800 Citizen Airmen who are part of the 512th AW, which is the only Air Force Reserve unit in Delaware.
