Civilians can check personnel info online

Air Force Civilian Service employees are now able to access their electronic Official Personnel Folder, or eOPF, for up to 60 days following their date of separation.

This new capability allows employees to log into the AFPC Secure website from a personal computer using a user ID and password and download a copy of their final separation Standard Form 50, Notification of Personnel Action, or any other eOPF document. *(Courtesy AFPC)*

Deadline nears for Retroactive Stop Loss

Airmen, veterans and beneficiaries who were involuntarily extended under Stop Loss between Sept. 11, 2001, and Sept. 30, 2009, are eligible for Retroactive Stop Loss Special Pay. If an Airman's enlistment was involuntarily extended due to Stop Loss and he or she has yet to file a claim for RSLSP, the last day for that person to file is Oct. 21.
