COLONEL SHERRY L. TEAGUE

Col. Sherry L. Teague is the Commander of the 512th Maintenance Group, 512th Airlift Wing, an associate Air Force Reserve Command unit at Dover Air Force Base, Delaware. The 512th and the 436th Maintenance Groups team together to provide all logistical support required to sustain C-5 and C-17 aircraft.

Colonel Teague entered the Air Force in May 1990 as a graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy. Over the past 26 years, she has accumulated a wide range of active-duty, reserve and civilian experience specific to operations, maintenance and command-level support. As the 931st Maintenance Squadron Commander, she built the squadron from the ground up and was responsible for establishing squadron programs and recruiting personnel to support 63 KC-135 Stratotankers in a classic associate unit.

Additionally, Colonel Teague has significant real-world Air Operations Center, Air Force Forces staff experience gained through deployments and assignments both stateside and overseas, including Osan Air Base, Korea, where she worked in the AOC/AFFOR overseeing logistics for materials and personnel moving in support of operations Noble Eagle One, Enduring Freedom, Iraqi Freedom and coalition exercises including a 9th Air Force Blue Flag, Ulchi Focus Lens. She also spent three years on the Headquarters Air Force staff as the Deputy Chief, AOC/AFFOR Branch.



Colonel Teague previously served as the Individual Mobilization Augmentee to the 76th Aircraft Maintenance Group Commander, Tinker AFB, Okla., where she served a 3,600-person team responsible for depot repair, modification and overhaul of the KC-135, E-3 AWACS, B-1B and B-52 aircraft.
