Col. Arthur J. "Jeff" Rodi is the Commander of the 512th Mission Support Group, 512th Airlift Wing, an associate Air Force Reserve Command unit located at Dover Air Force Base, Delaware. He is the senior officer responsible for the 650-person organization, which supports Air Mobility Command's worldwide airlift mission, operating C-5 and C-17 aircraft.

Colonel Rodi initially enlisted in the regular Air Force in August 1978 as a supply specialist. Following an assignment to South Korea, he cross-trained into the logistics plans career field. He served on active duty for eight years before joining the AF Reserve in April 1987. He returned to active status in 1994 as an Active Guard Reserve technician and attained the rank of chief master sergeant while assigned to Headquarters Air Force Reserve Command. He was subsequently recognized as the Air Force Logistics Plans Command Manager of the Year in 1995. Colonel Rodi was commissioned through the Deserving Airman Commissioning Program in May 1998 and has held multiple assignments throughout his officer career. In June 2007, he became a personnel officer and has served as a flight, squadron and group commander as well as held several positions at the group, wing, numbered Air Force, major command and HQ levels. He has supported the following weapon systems: A-10, B-52, C-130, C-141, C-17, F-4, F-16, KC-10, KC-135 and MQ-9 airframes. Colonel Rodi previously served as the Commander, 452nd Mission Support Group, March Air Reserve Base, Calif.
