Col. William H. Gutermuth is the commander of the 512th Operations Group, 512th Airlift Wing, an Air Force Reserve Command associate wing located at Dover Air Force Base, Del. The 512th OG is comprised of the 326th Airlift Squadron, 709th Airlift Squadron, 512th Operations Support Squadron and the 512th Airlift Control Flight. He oversees the reserve flying operations and worldwide employment of the C-5M Super Galaxy and C-17A Globemaster III.

Colonel Gutermuth received his commission through the Air Force Officer Training School program in 1992 and directly entered into the Air Force Reserve following undergraduate pilot training at Laughlin AFB, Texas. He has deployed in support of operations Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom and Noble Eagle, accruing more than 350 combat flying hours. Prior to his attendance at the Inter-American Defense College, Colonel Gutermuth served as the Chief of the Aviation Branch, Headquarters AFRC Force Generation Center, Robins AFB, Ga., where he managed the volunteer battle rhythm and warfighter support for over 70,000 aviation and expeditionary



combat support forces and coordinated activation requests to support war and peacetime contingencies as well as national emergencies.
